VT Wetland Classification

Researched an evaluation of the extent to which the wetland

provides functions and values:



- Class I Wetland: Exceptional or irreplaceable. Highest level of protection. 100+ ft buffers
- Class II Wetland: Significant.
 Protected. (many VSWI mapped) 50ft buffers
- Class III Wetland: Neither Class I or Class II wetland. No State protection.



- 2016-2021: Wetland Rule Stakeholder Group Meetings
- 2019: Legislative Wetland Committee
- September 2022: General Wetland Determination
- January 2023: H.30 Wetland Bill Introduced
- Feb 2023: Wetland Rulechange Adopted
- May 2023: Sackett Decision
- July 2023: Flood (100 yr flood, 12 years after last 100 yr event)
- January 2024: S.213 Flood Safety Bill Introduced
- May 2024: Flood Safety Bill passes
