It is with tremendous heaviness of heart. that the Association of State Wetland Managers (ASWM) shares the sad news of the passing of ASWM's founder, Dr. Jon A. Kusler, Esg. After battling with Multiple System Atrophy for more than a year, Dr. Kusler passed away peacefully with his family at his side on Thursday, October 8th.

The global community of wetland and floodplain managers, scientists, policymakers, lawyers and practitioners have lost a colleague, a mentor and a friend. Jon payed the way for wetland and floodplain protection around the world, challenging us to think beyond the norm - to find new and innovative ways to solve some of our most pressing environmental issues.

ASWM has also created a Jon A. 




